

TRUTH UNDER SIEGE

Anonymous and fake accounts influenced and rallied real people to create and spread memes with simple, unified messages:

- · "Bias" that media groups are biased against Duterte.
- "Bayaran"/"Presstitutes" that journalists are paid and corrupt.
- "Oligarchs" Class war, and that journalists work for vested interests.
- "Clickbait" that media groups are commercial interests so they use clickbait headlines for cash initiatives.
- "Yellow" DDS vs Yellow; that the media is involved in a movement to bring back the Aquino government, and that if you are critical of the administration, you are anti-change and not pro-country
- "Fake News, Misinformation" that the media is the source of fake news and misinformation






BOTS
