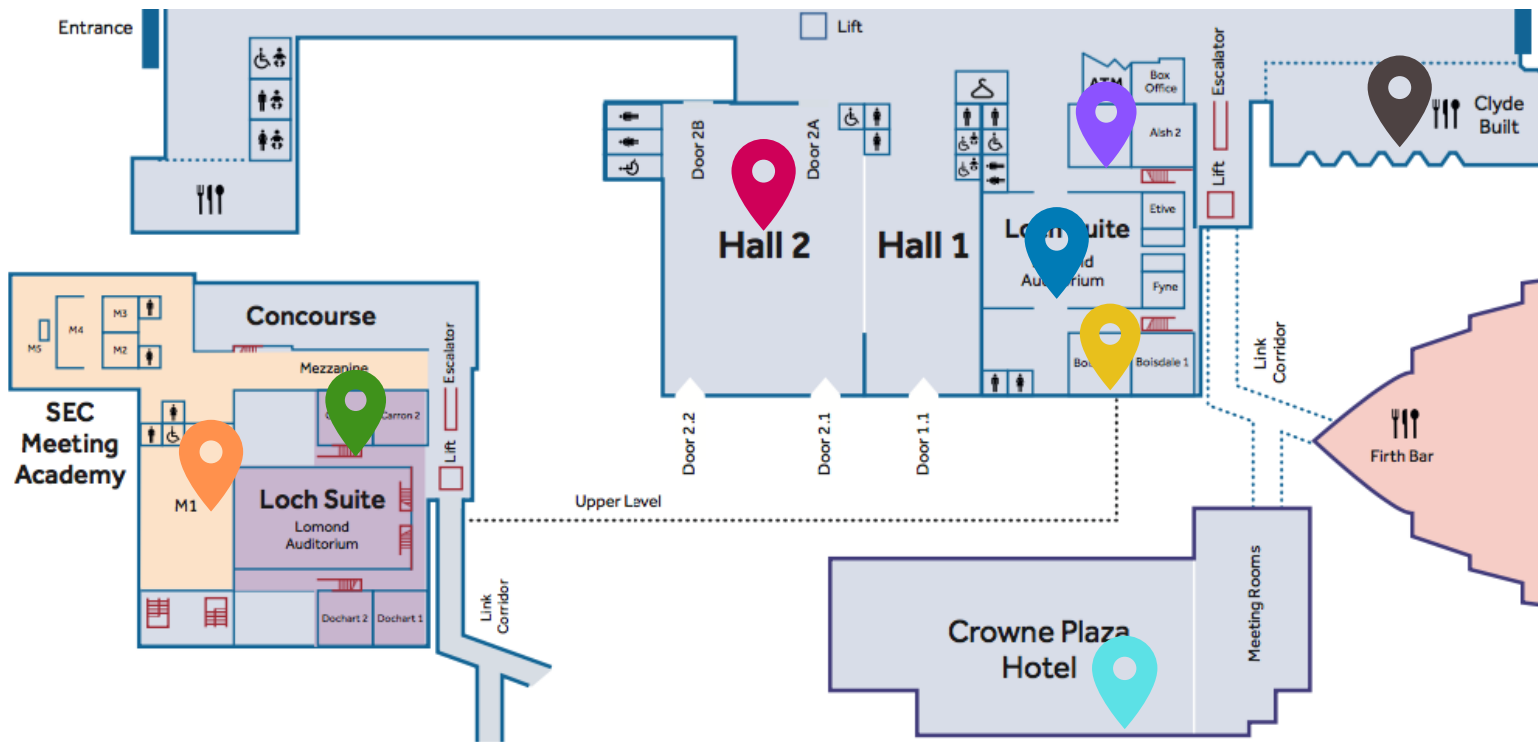

The Scottish Event Campus is a 15-minute taxi ride away from Glasgow Airport. Taxis are readily available 24 hours a day. The taxi rank is located at the front of the terminal building, a short walk from UK arrivals. The average taxi ride from the airport to the city costs £30. Taxis are metered but a list of charges is available at the taxi booking office next to the taxi rank. Credit cards are accepted.

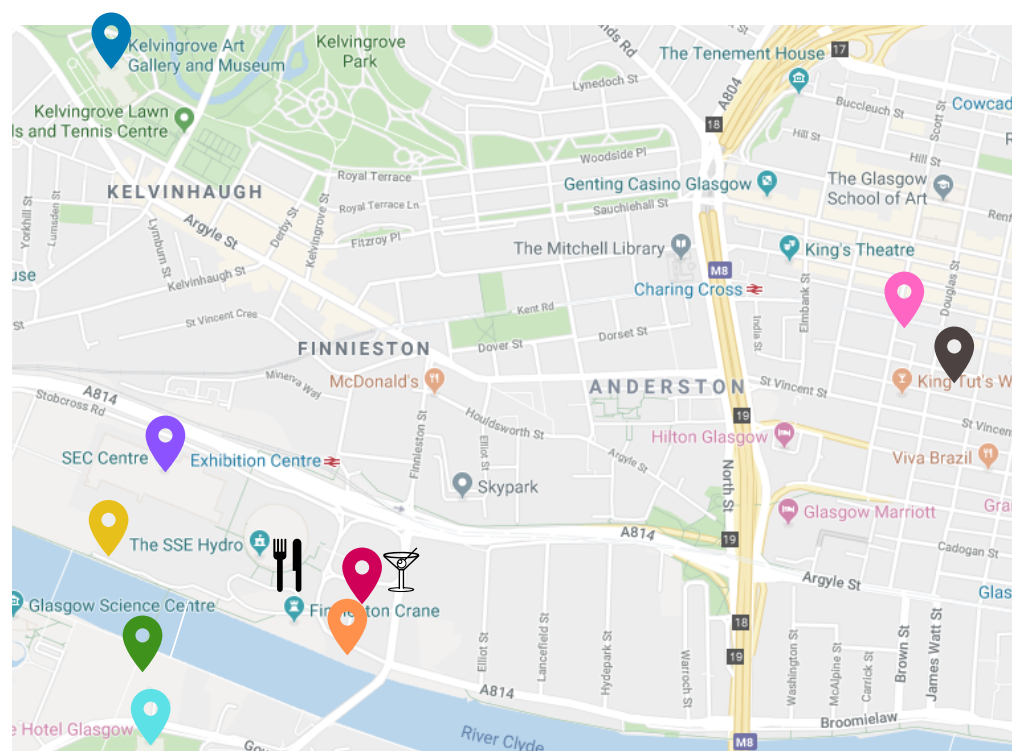
